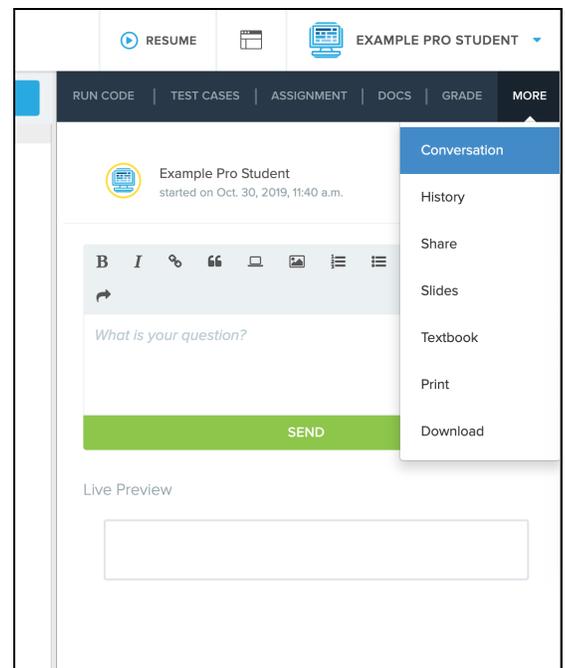
Communication & Support
